

Attended Funeral

(funeral directors charges only)

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Funeral Director's Charges Only	£2100.00
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£800.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£200.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's branch premises	£300.00
Providing a suitable coffin – made from wood effect Veneer	£350.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£0.00
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£450.00

Unattended Funeral

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1450.00
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)	£1100.00

FEES YOU MUST PAY	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee.	£300.00 – £1500.00
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:	
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; For an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee.	£1425.00

Guide to Third Party Fees

Funeral costs comprise of two sets of figures, our professional fees and fees paid to third parties.

Service in church including clergy followed by burial at a cemetery or attending the crematorium	from £200.00
Minister or civil celebrant attending crematorium only	from £220.00
Crematorium fees	from £790.00
Burial fees, these can vary considerably depending on chosen location	from £135.00
Grave digging	from £445.00
Press notices – Local newspapers	from £80.00
Press notices – National newspapers	from £250.00
Doctors fees for cremation certificates. Two doctors to complete cremation forms @ £82.00 each	£164.00
Floral Tributes	£2.50
Limousines to seat 6 people	£200.00
